FUNERAL BURIAL CEMETERY RULES

STAY HOME

DO NOT ATTEND if you are supposed to be self isolating. Your presence no matter how innocent may cause disruption to all those attending & may spread the infection further causing widespread difficulty.

5 PEOPLE MAXIMUM



Only five members/people as advised to the GMBC team by the family are allowed to attend

INFECTION CONTROL

All attending the funeral should wear a face mask. Adhere to social distancing at all times, including when travelling to & from the funeral (two meters from each other).

Social distancing must be done during the Janazah Salah.

Follow instructions and time given by GMBC ADMIN TEAM, as failure to do so will mean that the funeral will not take place and will be delayed until the next available slot.

After Janazah Salah, GMBC nominated volunteers will place the deceased in the grave & will then allow family members to come and throw some soil into the grave.

Family members should then move away from the grave to enable cemetery staff to back fill the grave and conclude with Duaa and leave on time as requested
